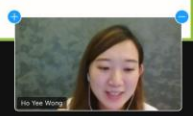


How do I start the sustainability journey?



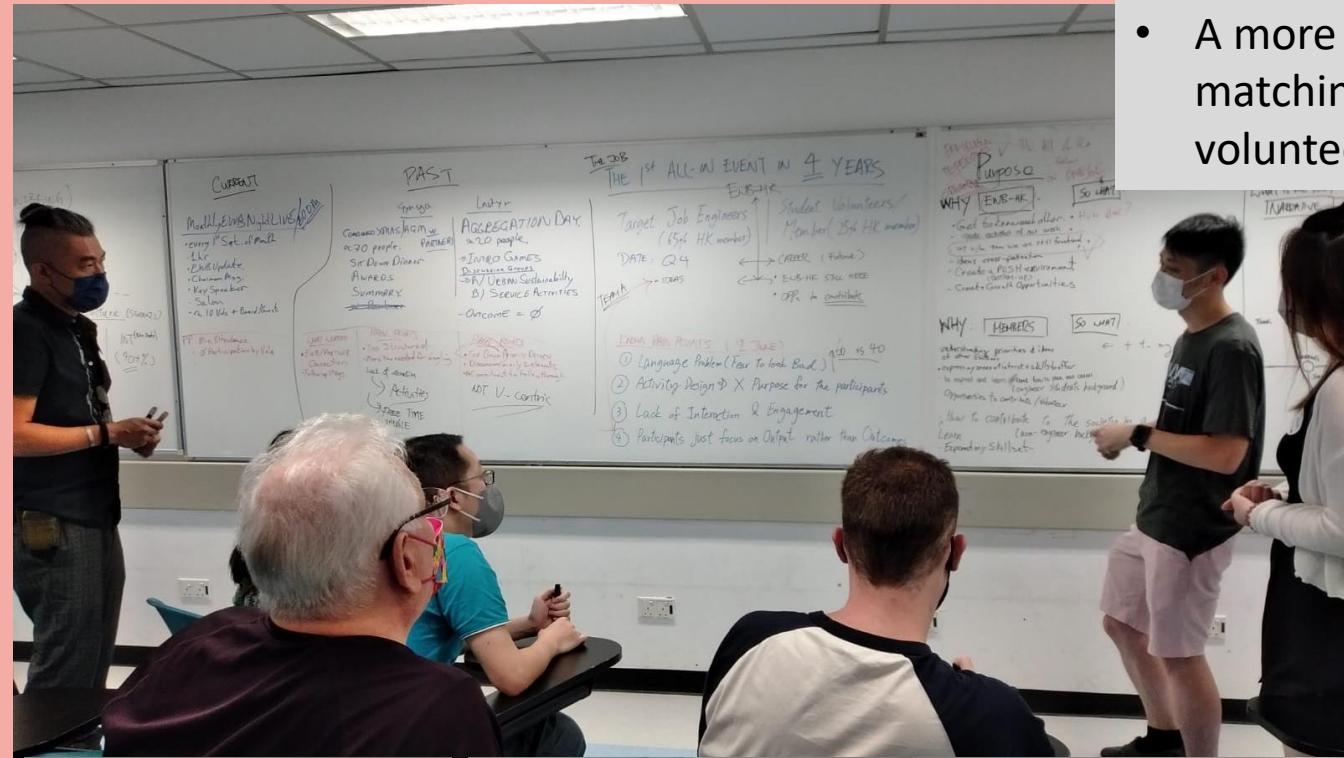
David Attenborough's planet series triggered my interest in environmental protection and earth science. It seeded my path to sustainability.

Humanity is critically challenged by climate change, ecosystem degradation and continued social inequality.


There is an important leadership role for engineering expertise to play in tackling the challenges faced by the global community.

EWB International Strategy Workshop

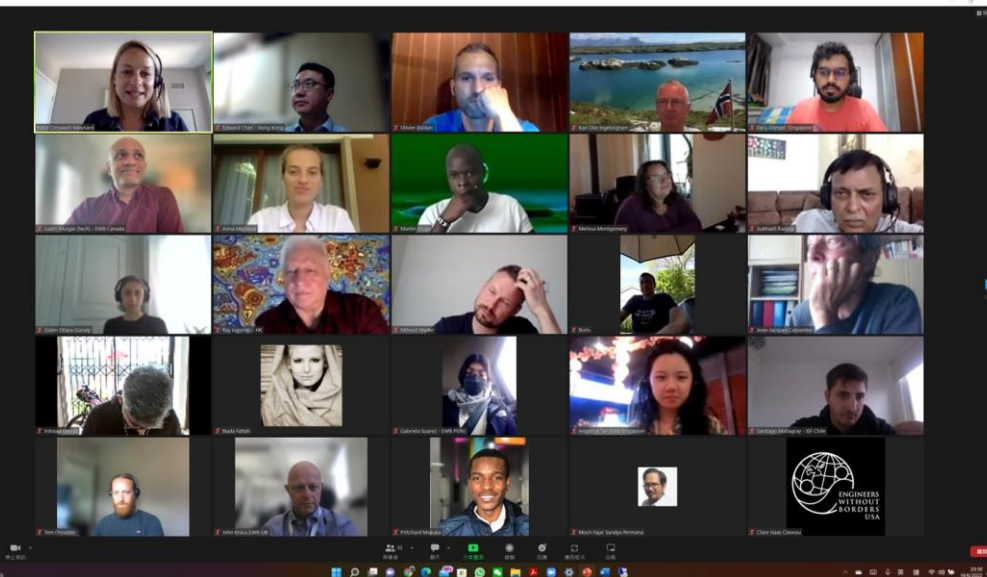
14,15 and 28,29 June 2022

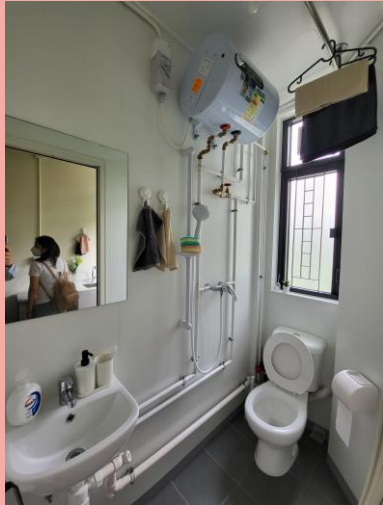


Lai Chi Wo River Improvement

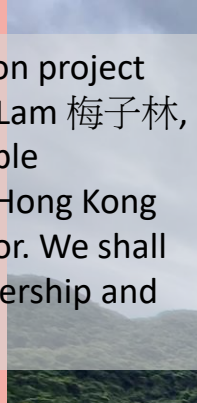
